

Danish Red Cross

The Danish Red Cross employs approximately 900 staff, which includes 100 delegates deployed internationally.

The General Assembly is the supreme authority of the Danish Red Cross and is composed of a representative from each local branch, members of the National Governing Board and the independent organisations of Greenland Red Cross, Faeroe Red Cross and the Danish Red Cross Youth. The General Assembly elects the Governing Board and an Election Committee tasked with preparing and coordinating the Governing Board elections.

In November 2018, the General Assembly elected Sven Bak-Jensen as President for a four-year period while Anne Lerche Nordlund was elected Vice President. The Governing Board consists of 16 members and meets a minimum of 6 times a year.

Anders Ladekarl has held the position as Secretary General of the Danish Red Cross since 2008. Birgitte Bischoff Ebbesen is Head of International Department.
